AN ACT

RELATING TO JUDICIARY AND ETHICS; AMENDING THE NAVAJO
NATION ETHICS IN GOVERNMENT LAW GARNISHMENT ACT OF 2005, 2
N.N.C. §3810

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Amendment

The Navajo Nation Council amends the Navajo Nation
Ethics in Government Law Garnishment Act of 2005, 2 N.N.C.
§3810 as follows:

§3810. Maximum allowable earnings subject to garnishment

The maximum amount of earnings subject to garnishment
shall not exceed the lesser of:

- A. Fifteen percent (15%) of the judgment
~~creditor's~~ debtor's disposable income for any
pay period; or
- B. The amount by which the judgment ~~creditor's~~
debtor's disposable income exceeds 30 times the
federal minimum wage (based on a 40 hour work
week) in effect at the time the earnings are
payable).

Section 2. Effective Date


These amendments shall be effective upon approval.

Section 3. Codification

These amendments shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel in the next recodification or supplement of the Navajo Nation Code to the extent practicable.


