
Chapter Meetings

 - Transportation
 - Access to care
 - Proximity of accessing care
 - How do you coordinate w/MCO now
 - How would you like to coordinate in future
 - Care Coordination/Case Management
 - CHR/CHW role and responsibility
 - Clinical or non-clinical
 - Member Education about benefits
 - Services being provided without compensation
